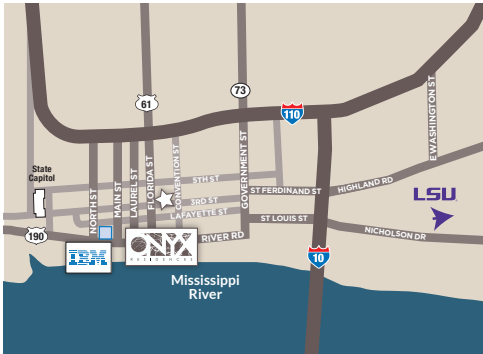

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**Located at the main corner of the arts and entertainment district, Onyx Residences are the perfect place to call home for today's young professional.** Living in the middle of the arts, music, theatre, and restaurant scene of downtown while being able to walk to work are just part of the conveniences at Onyx. These 27, 1 & 2 bedroom apartments with balconies overlooking Third and Convention Streets are just a block away from North Boulevard Town Square. The original Onyx Building opened in the 1950s and was the home of Rider's Jewelry store until the late 1970s. Today, the completely new Onyx Residences stand five stories tall, and some of the original marble panels have been repurposed on the exterior of the new building.



The Onyx Building is part of the Arts Block that was formed as one of the partnerships that brought about Baton Rouge's successful downtown revitalization. Bounded by North Boulevard and Lafayette, Convention and Third Streets, the Arts Block includes the Shaw Center for the Arts, the LSU Museum of Art, The Manship Theatre complex, several restaurants, a coffee shop, and One Eleven Lofts.

Features include: granite countertops, stainless steel appliances, washer & dryer, custom-built kitchen islands with drop-pendant lighting, hardwood floors, and balconies.

Pets are welcome. Storage units are available.
